

Washing Instructions: Cotton and Terry Cloth Gloves

Cotton and Terry Cloth Gloves should be washed with the following instructions to avoid shrinkage and prolong the life of the gloves.

1. Use commercial laundry soap or detergent that does not contain chlorine-based chemicals, bleach, or dry cleaning solutions. Oxi-clean or equivalent is the preferred detergent to avoid shrinkage of cotton and terry cloth gloves.
2. Machine-wash in warm-hot water up to 400°F. Recommended to wash at 170°F for 15 minutes for optimal results.
3. Rinse in warm-hot water up to 400°F. Recommended to rinse at 170°F for 15 minutes for optimal results.
4. Recommended air-drying for optimal results. Tumble-drying in a machine is NOT recommended.
5. Repeat wash and rinse if gloves contain heavy dirt or grease. You may use several pieces of heavy canvas/cotton in the second wash to help remove deep grime from the gloves.



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
