

Washing Instructions: Kevlar[®] Gloves



Gloves or sleeves containing Kevlar[®] should be washed with the following instructions to avoid shrinkage and prolong the life of the gloves.

- Use commercial laundry soap or detergent that does not contain chlorine-based chemicals, bleach, or dry cleaning solutions. Oxi-clean or equivalent is the preferred detergent to avoid shrinkage of Kevlar[®] gloves.
- 2. Machine wash in warm-hot water up to 400°F. Recommended to wash at 170°F for 15 minutes for optimal results.
- 3. Rinse in warm-hot water up to 400°F. Recommended to rinse at 170°F for 15 minutes for optimal results.
- 4. Recommended tumble dry at 170°F for 15 minutes for optimal results.
- 5. Repeat wash and rinse if gloves contain heavy dirt or grease. You may use several pieces of heavy canvas/cotton in the second wash to help remove deep grime from the gloves.

Special notes: Kevlar[®] knit gloves may compress after wash and dry, but will still expand to fit the same size hand.
